### **RULES AND GUIDELINES**

- 1. Complete the Student Registration Form. Submit three copies of your selected essay topic. Attach and staple one of those copies to your Registration Form.
- 2. Must be a graduating senior with an overall GPA of no less than 2.75.
- 3. Must be planning to attend an institution of higher learning (e.g. 2 or 4 yr. college or trade school) upon graduation.
- 4. Submit a certified copy of your high school transcript.
- 5. Must submit 3 letters of recommendations:
  - a. Counselor/school administrator
  - b. Teacher
  - c. Representative from your community who is familiar with your community service activities (No Relatives).
- 6. All entries must be mailed or hand delivered in mailbox to the following address:

- 7. Deadline for all entries: April 4, 2025
  - a. Mailed entries must be postmarked no later than April 4, 2025.
  - b. Entries hand delivered to the office mailbox must be brought in before close of business, 5:00pm.



#### Judging:

Essays will be scored anonymously by a team of judges. Judging will not only be based on conventional writing standards (such as grammar, organization, etc.) but also on the expressiveness of ideas and experiences.

- 1. Select one topic to write your essay on:
  - I. As a young person, I have remained drug-free because... OR
  - II. When I become an adult, I plan to help my home and community to remain drug-free by...
- 2. Do not place your name or your school's name on any of the pages of the essay. Each page must be numbered.
- 3. Essay must be no fewer than 400 and no more than 600 words in length, double spaced. You must also submit a word count at the end of the essay.
- 4. Entries must be in 12-point Times New Roman with a one-inch margin on all sides of the page.
- 5. Plagiarism or use of another's ideas without proper attribution is strictly prohibited.
